Researchers appointed at a higher education institution for at least the duration of proposed project. Academics at all levels, clinicians, postdoctoral fellows, postgraduate students are eligible to apply but must include a faculty member as a co-PI on the application.

Proposal components:

- 2. Description of your new solution / answer
- 3. Difference to the current 'Gold Standard' / uniqueness of new solution
- 4. Market niche and size (Africa and other regions)
- 5. Current development stage and future development plan
- 6. Which part of your technology shall be patented?
- 7. Applicant credentials (brief description of why the team is suitable to pursue this project)
- 8. CV of the PI and other key team members (not part of page limit)
- 9. Budget (also not part of the page limit)
